Event: Case Management

Target: 9th, 10th and 11th grade

Activity: Site Coordinator visits parents and students at their homes during the evening hours to inform parents about their child's academics. During the home visit Site Coordinator opens up dialogue with parents about encouraging their child to be proactive and focus on getting good grades and take challenging courses now, to get prepared for college.
